



Increase Access for Low Income Equity Plan

Bikeshare is a breakthrough for people with low income and housing insecurity

- Pre-paid card program
- Low cost / No cost passes, subsidized
- Identify groups- in person, at their location



Tourists Love Bikeshare Have money to spend A joyful, first way-in to bike life

- Tourists need easy access, at hotels
- Ready to spend money for local experiences
- Locals too bike for a friend who visits

Hotel Packages Bike Tour options Tourism Promotion Tourists want to know in advance

- Marketing tourists plan ahead of time
- Work w tourism industry shares story
- Hotel packages

Attractive. Signage. Easy human response to Qs. Scooters unsafe: tiny wheel radius, throw-away. Keep bikes looking great & stations clean

- Special signage for tourists at station
- Access to staff for immediate help by phone
- Challenge kids can't ride
- Scootershare trains people mistreat equipment



Clarify for everyone Decrease shenanigans Get tech right

I came home, showered, bike is in garage Why 24-36 hours? Bike in wild 4+ hours is trouble Clear Processes & Communication

- Don't say "rent"
- It's transit it's a Bikeshare "Pass"
- Police Dept can't respond until contract up
- Changed: after 8 hours bike is stolen
- Watch bikes after 2 hours out

Grand Theft conviction Access for people in need

Work with Police Department closely

- Major bike thief convicted
- Change Word on the Street
- Pre-paid card process for people in need

- New locking tech










