> CMO has funded 36 Community Transportation Needs Assessments to evalu transportation gaps and identify mobility challenges, preferences and priorities

 There are currently nine bikeshare projects funded by CMO in Redding, Rialto, Stockton, Huron, Oakland, Fresno and San Pedro, San Jose and Santa Barbara.

> Project models include docked and free floating bikeshare, and bike libraries


